

SAVC PEER REVIEW APPLICATION – SCREENING FOR PEER REVIEW PROCESS

Introduction

The criteria as listed below is only to enter the peer review process. Acceptance for peer review is in no way a guarantee that the peer review process will be successful; i.e. meeting the minimum requirements for peer review does not equate in any way to meeting the minimum requirements for specialisation. Two (2) expert peer reviewers' insight and critical considered evaluation of the application will be applied and presented to the SAVC Committee on Specialisation.

Checklist

To enter the peer review process (for registration as a veterinary specialist), the applicant must clearly and convincingly demonstrate the following:

	Criteria for acceptance to enter the peer review process	Tick and provide proof
1	be registered with the SAVC as a veterinarian;	
2	provide a letter of good standing from the SAVC;	
3	have a post-graduate qualification, at a minimum a Master's degree or other higher post-graduate qualification that is acceptable to the Committee on Specialisation;	
4	have a minimum of 7 years' experience in the field of specialisation;	
5	have spent at least 60% of his/her time during the above period in the field of specialisation;	
6	have peer-reviewed publication(s) in the field of specialisation as primary or senior author;	
7	have presented relevant original work at scientific meetings in the field of specialisation;	
8	proof of acceptance by colleagues and peers as possessing knowledge, experience and skills at the level of a specialist, including letters of reference from registered specialists and/or other relevant recognised experts; and	

9	give a detailed description of how the relevant expertise was achieved.
