Compulsory community service. -</p> <p>(1) From the date of commencement of section 3 of the Veterinary and Para-Veterinary Professions Amendment Act, 2012, any person registering for the first time to practise a veterinary profession or para-veterinary profession in terms of this Act, shall perform in the prescribed manner compulsory community service in that veterinary profession or para-veterinary profession for a period of one year and shall, upon completion of such service, be entitled to practise the profession for which he or she is registered.</p> <p>2) The Minister may, after consultation with the council, prescribe the performance of compulsory community service contemplated in subsection(1), including but not limited to—</p> <p>(a) the registration of persons for compulsory community service;</p> <p>(b) the conditions of employment pertaining to persons who perform such service;</p> <p>(c) the places at which compulsory community service is to be performed; and</p> <p>(d) the conditions subject to which the service may be interrupted.</p> <p>(3) The Minister may, after consultation with the council, prescribe the circumstances under which a person contemplated in subsection (1) may be exempted from performance of the compulsory community service.
